WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF JOINING THE DIVE CLUB?

Club members get great discounts on gear hire and are entitled to 10% discount (in addition to any special offers) on everything at The Robinhood Watersports Shop. This could mean a BIG saving on the price of your gear.

As club members we can get air fills for £2.50 This is much cheaper than the £4.00 average price charged at dive sites.

Oxygen & First Aid Kits are freely available on dive trips and for members to use.

WHEN CAN I DIVE?

We generally dive every weekend of the year. (including the winter!!) and often in mid-week as well. There are organised dive trips for all levels of experience and interest throughout the main diving season (May to October) and we also go on diving holidays.

Of course not everything is diving. We have a lot of social events as well. These involve a combination of Barbeques, Bowling, Charity Do's, Chinese's, Curries, Family Fun Days... and lots more.
